(2) Reasons

For the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026, net sales rose to a record high and all of operating profit, ordinary profit, and profit attributable to owners of parent outperformed the forecasts owing to a significant increase in sales thanks to growth in demand for generative AI-related testing and significant improvement in product mix in the CTC segment.

For the fiscal year ending March 31, 2027, the global economy is facing increasing uncertainties from the escalating political confrontations, tensions, and conflicts in various regions. However, the CTC segment is expected to grow further against the backdrop of expanding demand for generative AI-related testing, and fund demand at the Company for capital expenditures, including investments to expand production capacity, remains high.

Under such circumstances and also comprehensively taking into consideration shareholder returns as well as fund demand and financial stability in the next fiscal year and onward, the Company decided to submit a proposal to pay a year-end dividend of ¥31 per share (up ¥4 per share compared with the most recent dividend forecast) for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 at the 88th Ordinary General Meeting of Shareholders scheduled to be held on June 26, 2026. This will result in an annual dividend of ¥56 per share for the fiscal year (consolidated payout ratio of 33.6% and DOE of 2.3%) including the interim dividend of ¥25 per share it has already paid.
